Step 7: Sharing Jesus with Others

A. Purpose:

It is natural for us to want to share good news with others. The more exciting the news, the more eager we are to share it with those we know and care about. As Christians we have exciting news to share—life-changing news of eternal life and an inheritance in heaven with God. The Bible says that to believe we first have to be drawn toward Jesus when we hear about the Good News.

Romans 10:14 *How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? NKJV*

Romans 10:17 *So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. NKJV*

God wants you to become part of helping others to hear about Jesus. We call the command for each of us to tell others about Christ "The Great Commission."

Matthew 28:19-20 *(Jesus commanded,) "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." NKJV*

B. Summary

There are two important things you should use when sharing your faith in Jesus Christ:

1. Your personal Testimony
 - Your personal testimony is the story of your own experience with Jesus
 - You should learn to tell your story briefly and well
2. Scripture: There are several series of Scriptures that can illustrate the steps to salvation
