Every part of Scripture is God-breathed and useful one way or another—showing us truth, exposing our rebellion, correcting our mistakes, training us to live God's way. 2 Timothy 3:16 (TM)

4. GROWLOVE - gives me \_\_\_\_\_.

[Scripture is given] that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work. 2 Timothy 3:17 (NKJV)
